**BULLETIN TO MEMBERS
ORDER OF THE FEDERAL COURT**

Following proceedings in the Federal Court, the Court has issued an interim order, until Monday 24 December, that all industrial action in the workplaces noted below, by allied health professionals, cease. Consequently members and delegates are directed to “lift all bans, limitations and restrictions on the performance of work and all other industrial action at a place or places of work operated by” Austin Health; Barwon Health; Bayside Health; Melbourne Health; Northern Health; Southern Health; Western Health; Eastern Health and St Vincent’s Hospital.

The order does not apply to protected action but members are advised that no protected action is currently in place.

The union is in the process of putting in place protected action in all public hospital workplaces and has given notice of protected action to commence at Peter McCallum Cancer Center, Melbourne Health, Western Health and Northern Health.

The union will apply to Industrial Relations Commission for protected action ballots in all other public sector workplaces.

Conciliation with government and employers will continue tomorrow (Saturday) in the Industrial Relations Commission before Vice-President Lawler.
